



Ca' Lunae La Bianca

Cantine Lunae is the Bosoni family, located in La Spezia, Liguria with emphasis on native varieties and a blend of traditional winemaking with state-of-the-art equipment. With a prime location, they have “million-dollar” views from many of their vineyards, overlooking the sea, the northern tip of Tuscany, and on a cloudless day, the “finger” of Corsica.

Denomination: Liguria di Levante IGT Bianco

Grape Varieties: Vermentino, Malvasia di Candia Aromatica

Alcohol Content: 12.5% abv

Territory: Piana di Luni

Vinification: Fermentation at controlled temperatures in steel, ageing on the fine lees in steel for approximately 4 months.

Tasting Notes: This wine was born from the union of two traditional vines. The grapes come from vineyards cultivated in the light and sandy lands of the plain of Luni, nestled between the Ligurian Sea and the Apuan Alps. This is the territory of Vermentino which lends a fresh and delicate wine, rich in savoury notes of sage and Mediterranean scrub, peppermint, and white pepper, with the addition of Malvasia di Candia Aromatica contributing aromas and flavours of pineapple, passionfruit, mango, and fragrant spring flowers. The finish, like many Vermentino from the area will end with a salty tang.

Pairing Suggestions: fruit salad, chocolate covered strawberries or pasta with a butter-sage sauce.
